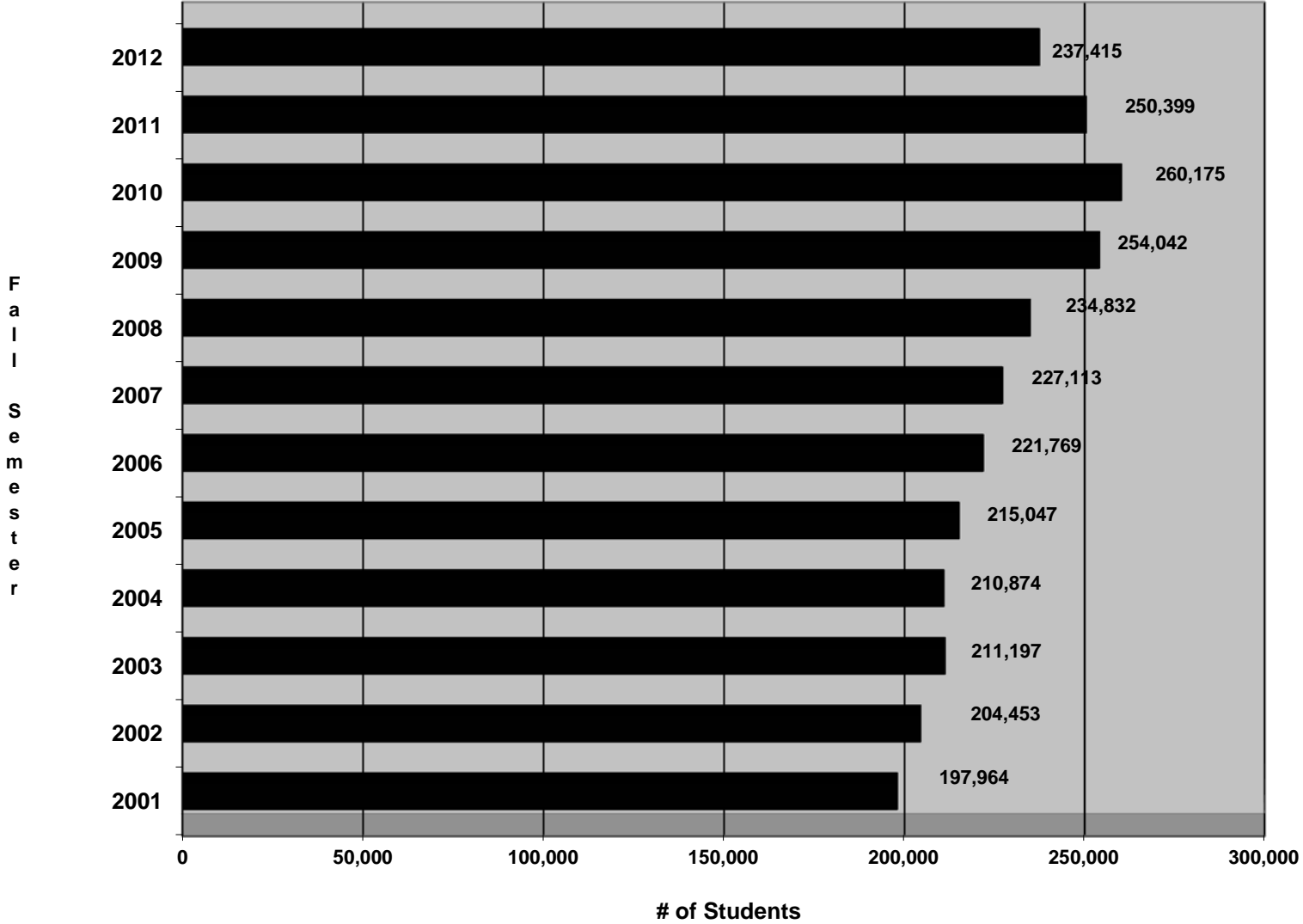
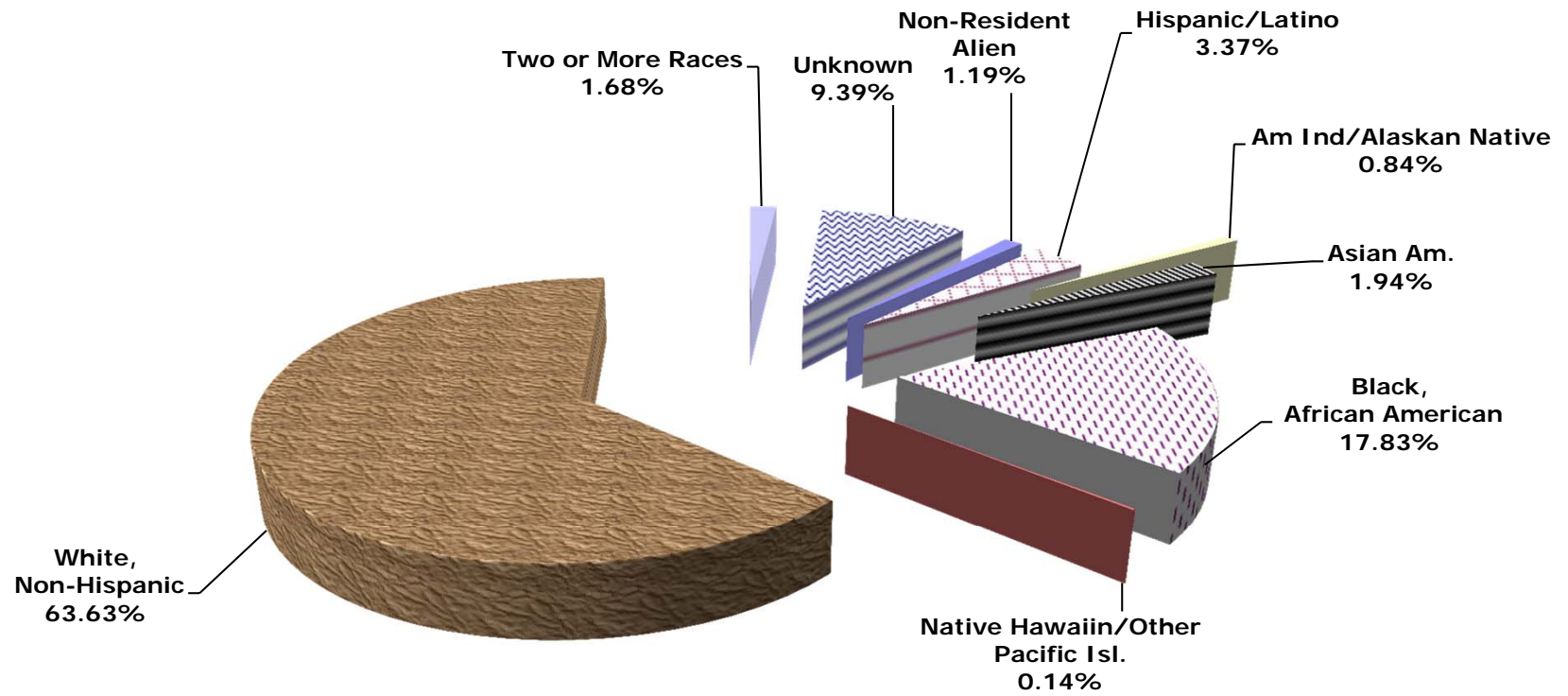

NUMBER of FITIAC's AS COMPARED TO FALL ENROLLMENT, 2003 THROUGH 2012

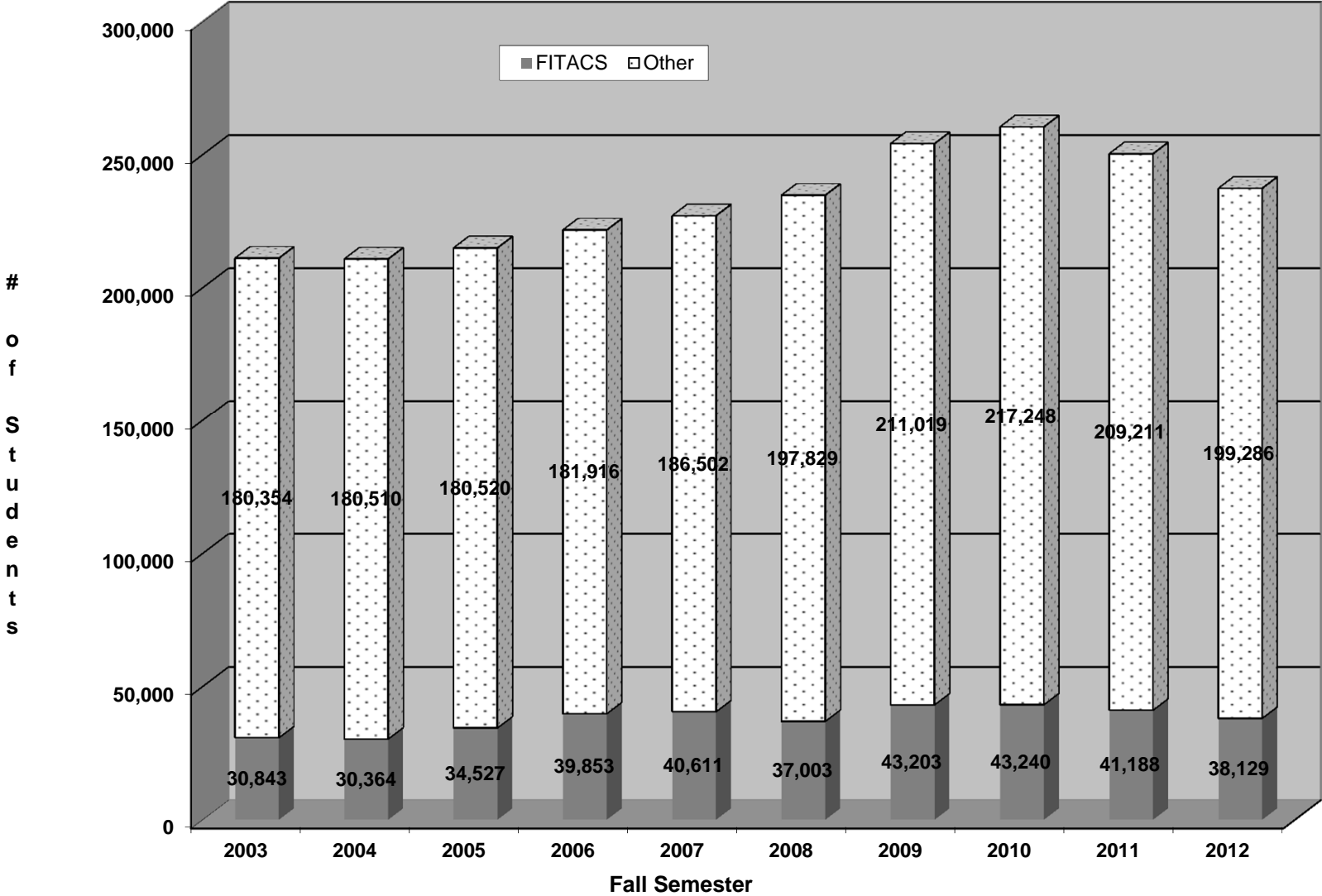

ENROLLMENT BY STATUS, FALL 2004 - FALL 2012

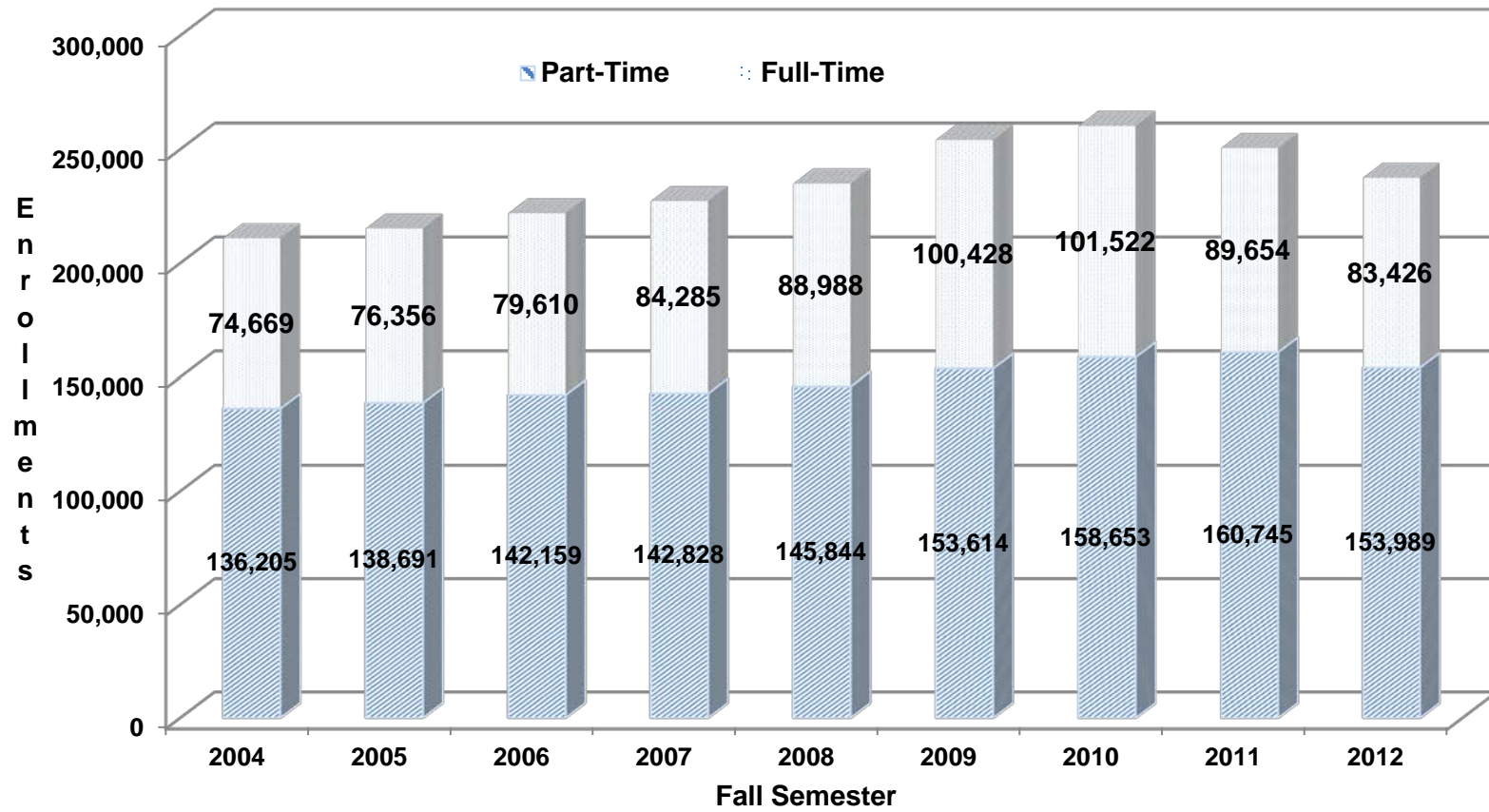

FALL 2012 ENROLLMENT BY AGE

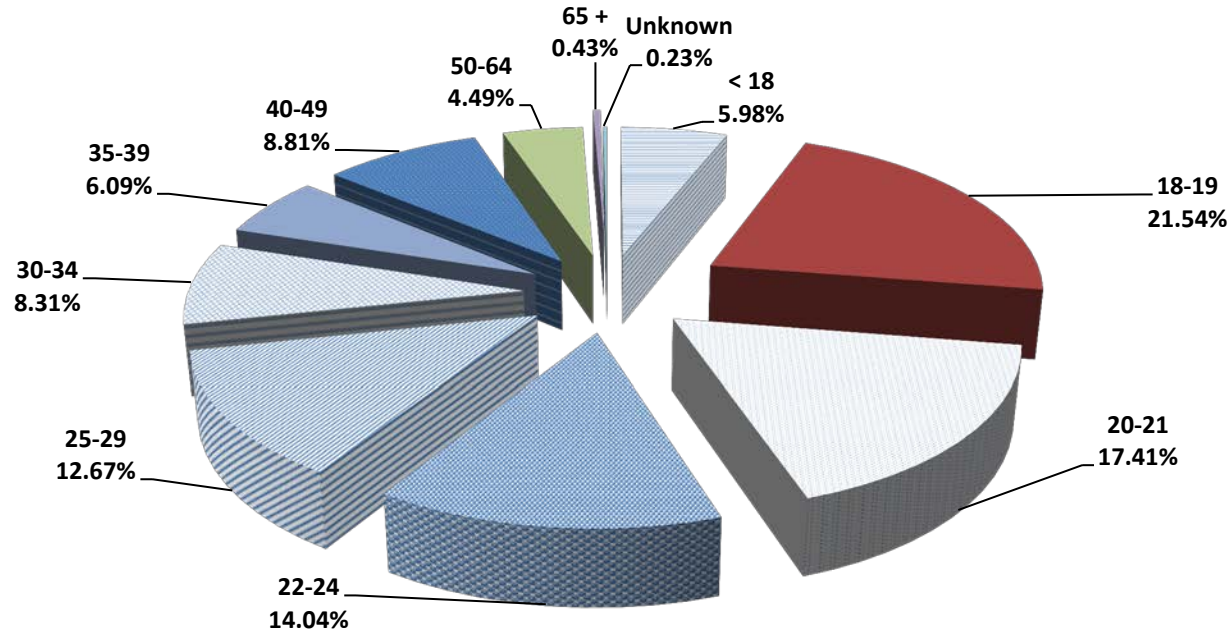
