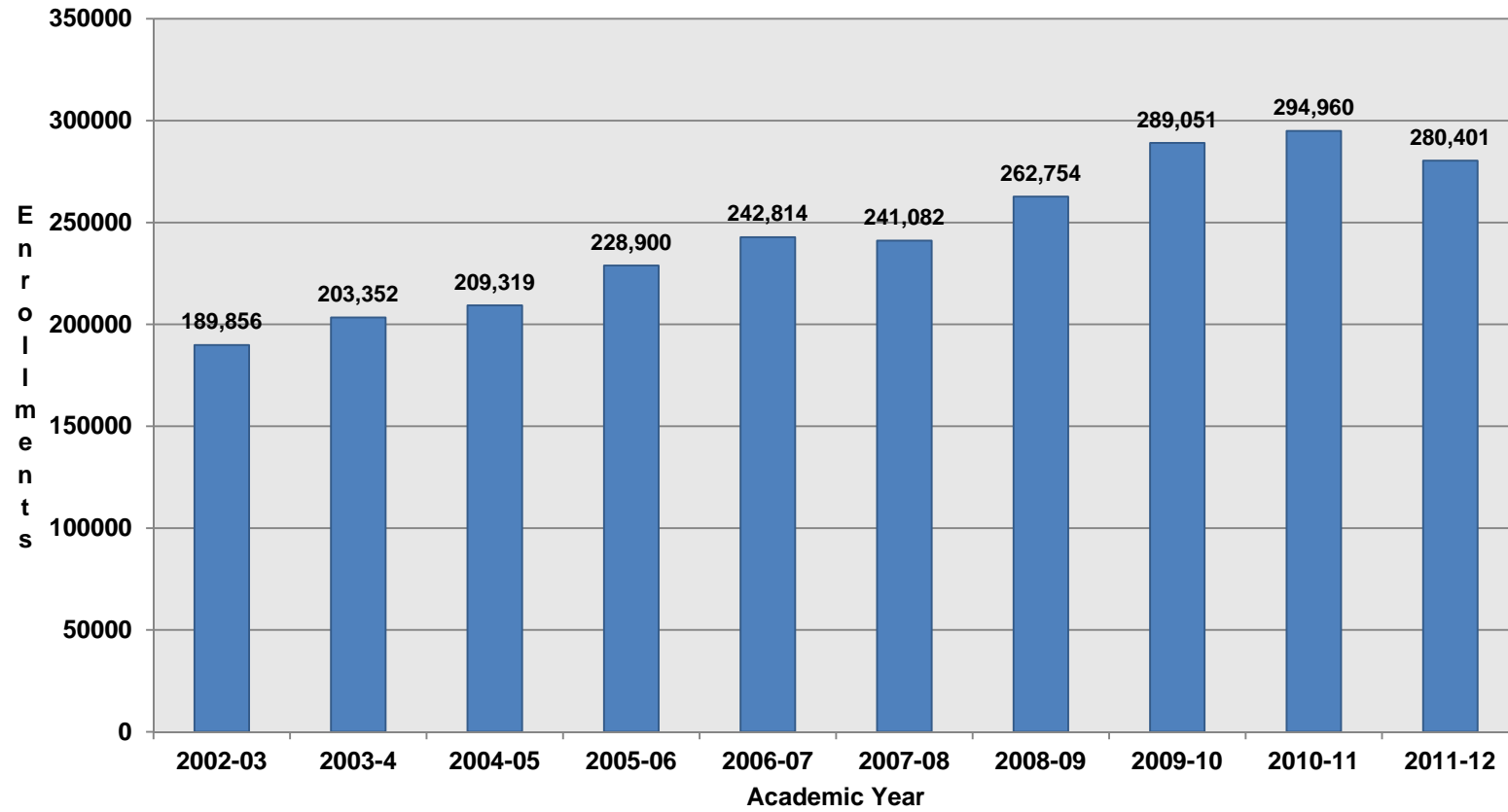


HISTORY OF YEAR-END PROGRAM ENROLLMENTS, 2002-03 THROUGH 2011-12



Although enrollments steadily increased from 2007-08 to 2010-11, there was a 4.9% decline from 2010-11 to 2011-12.

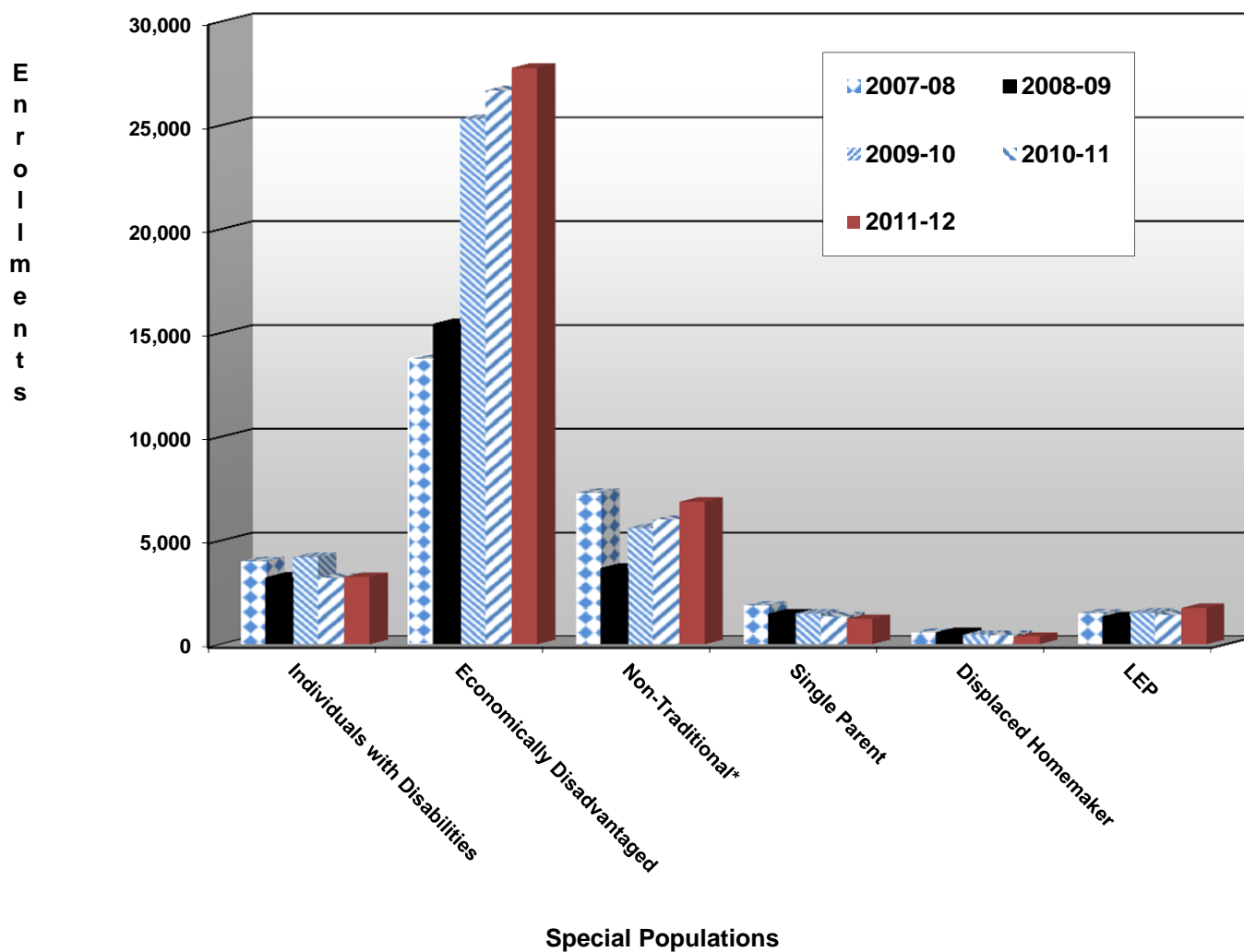
