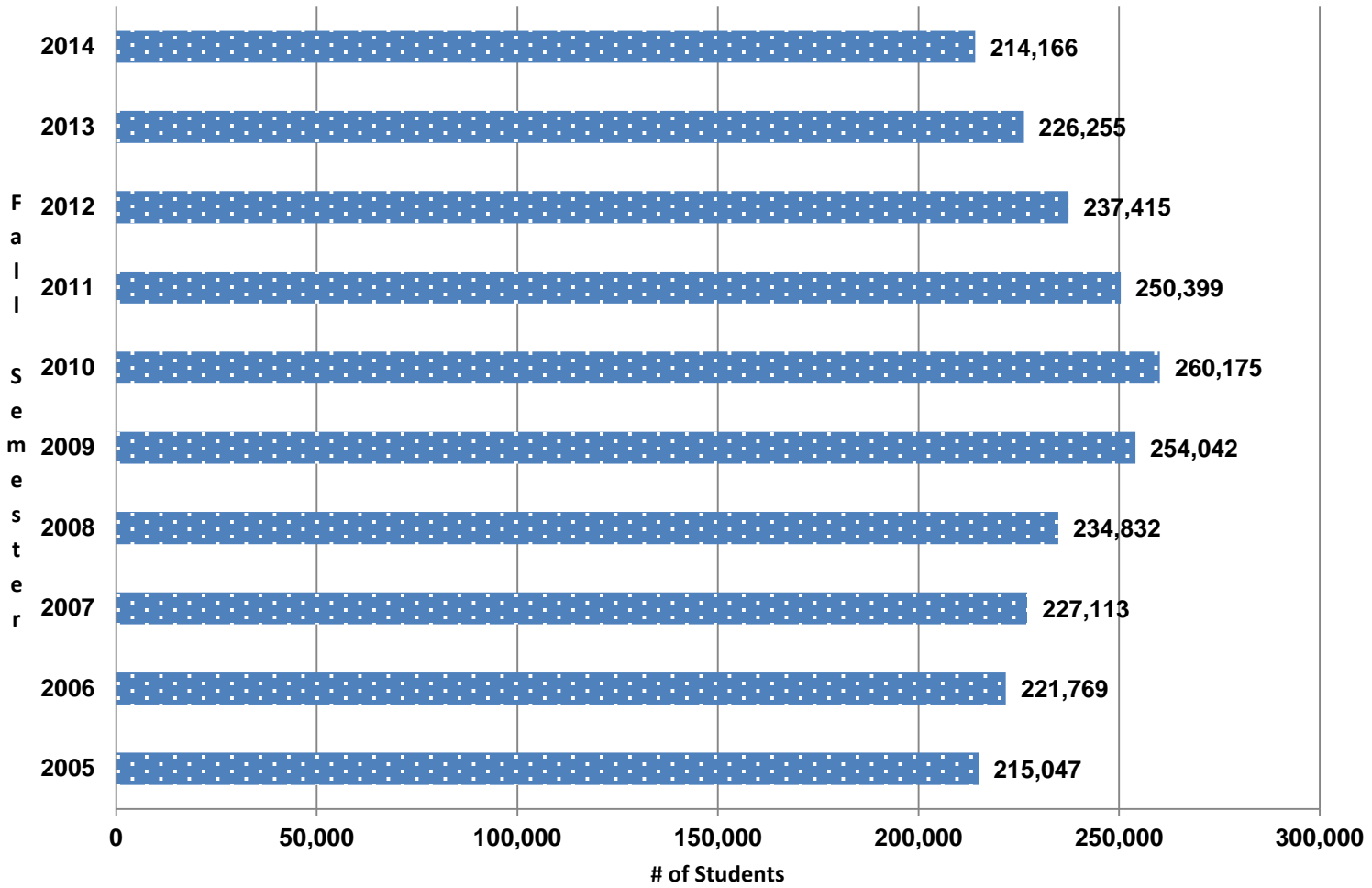
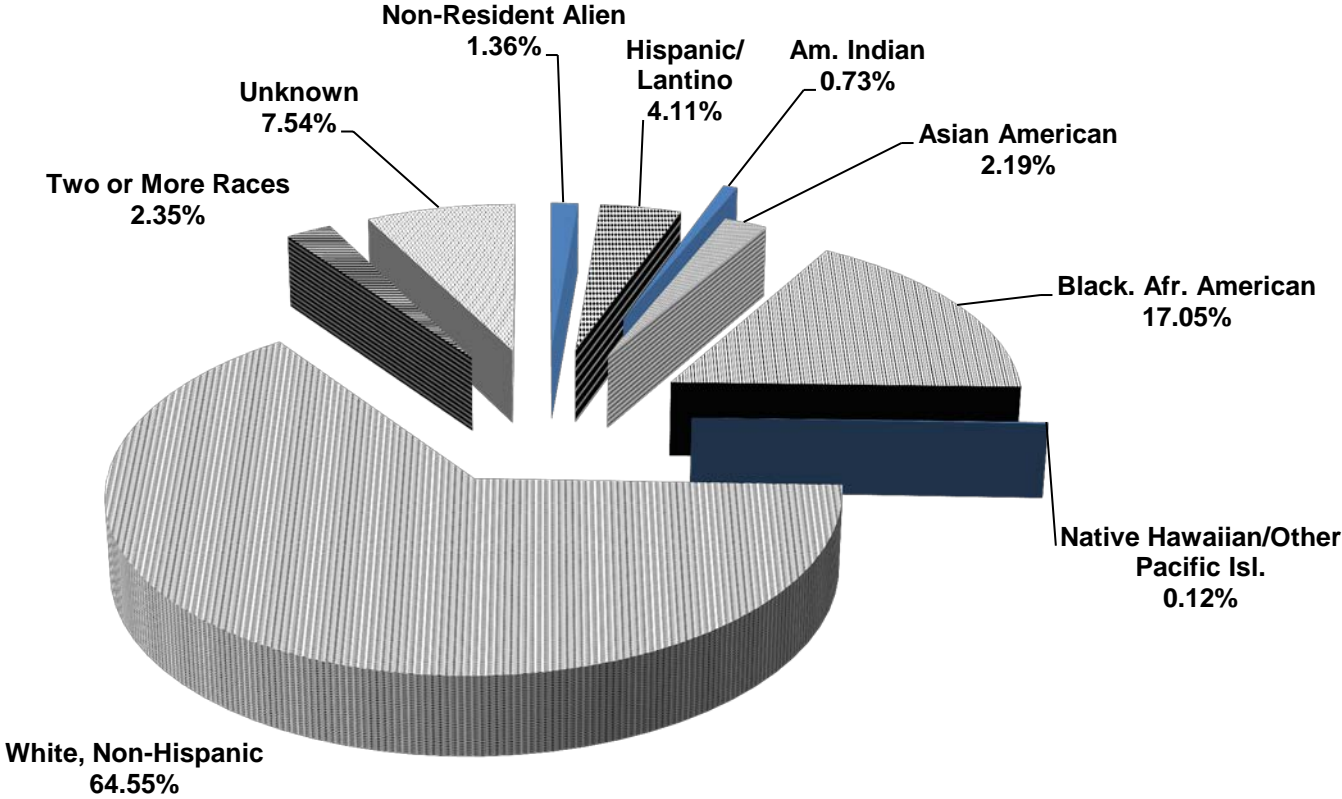

NUMBER of FITIAC's AS COMPARED TO FALL ENROLLMENT, 2004 THROUGH 2014

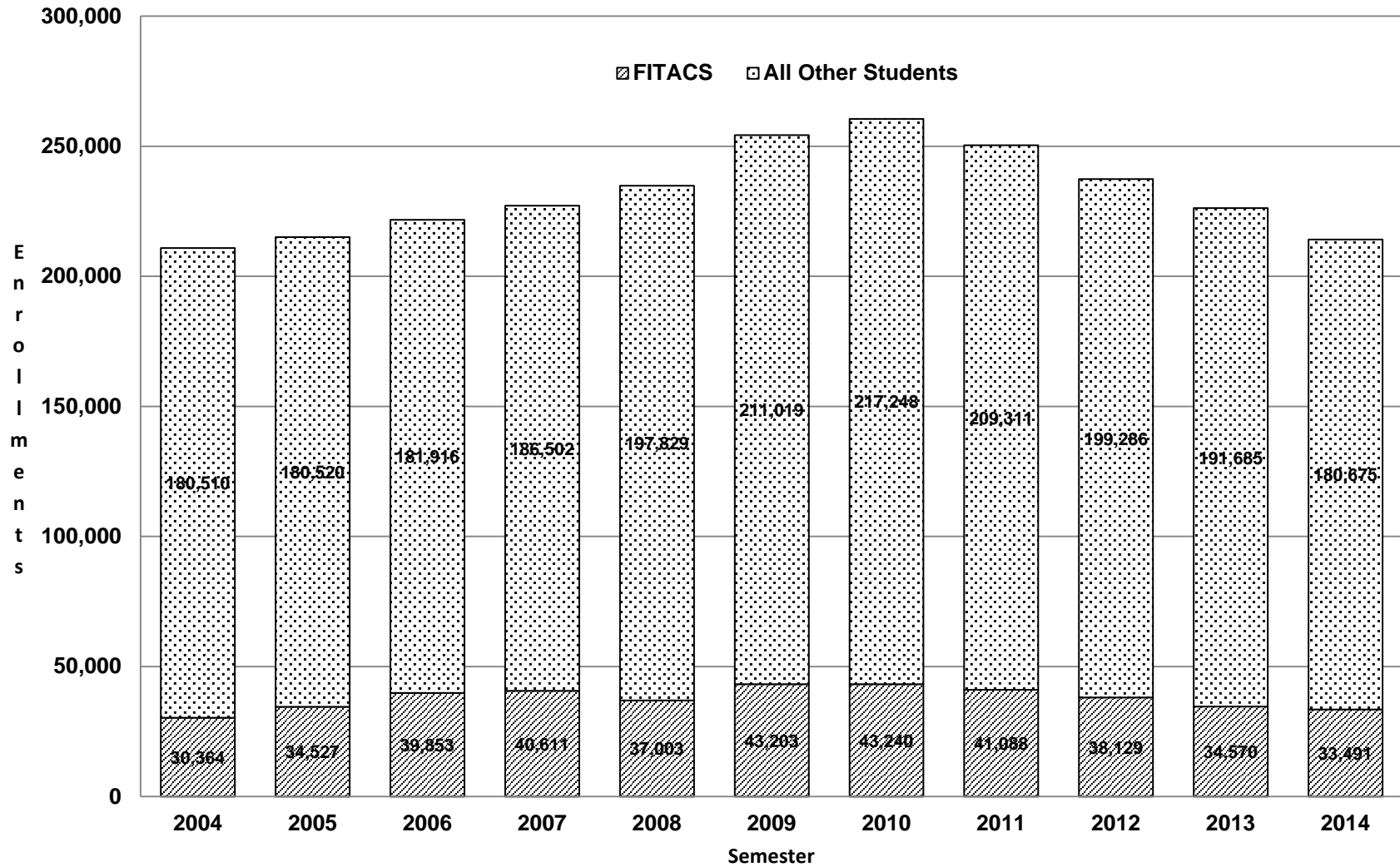

ENROLLMENT BY STATUS, FALL 2010 - FALL 2014

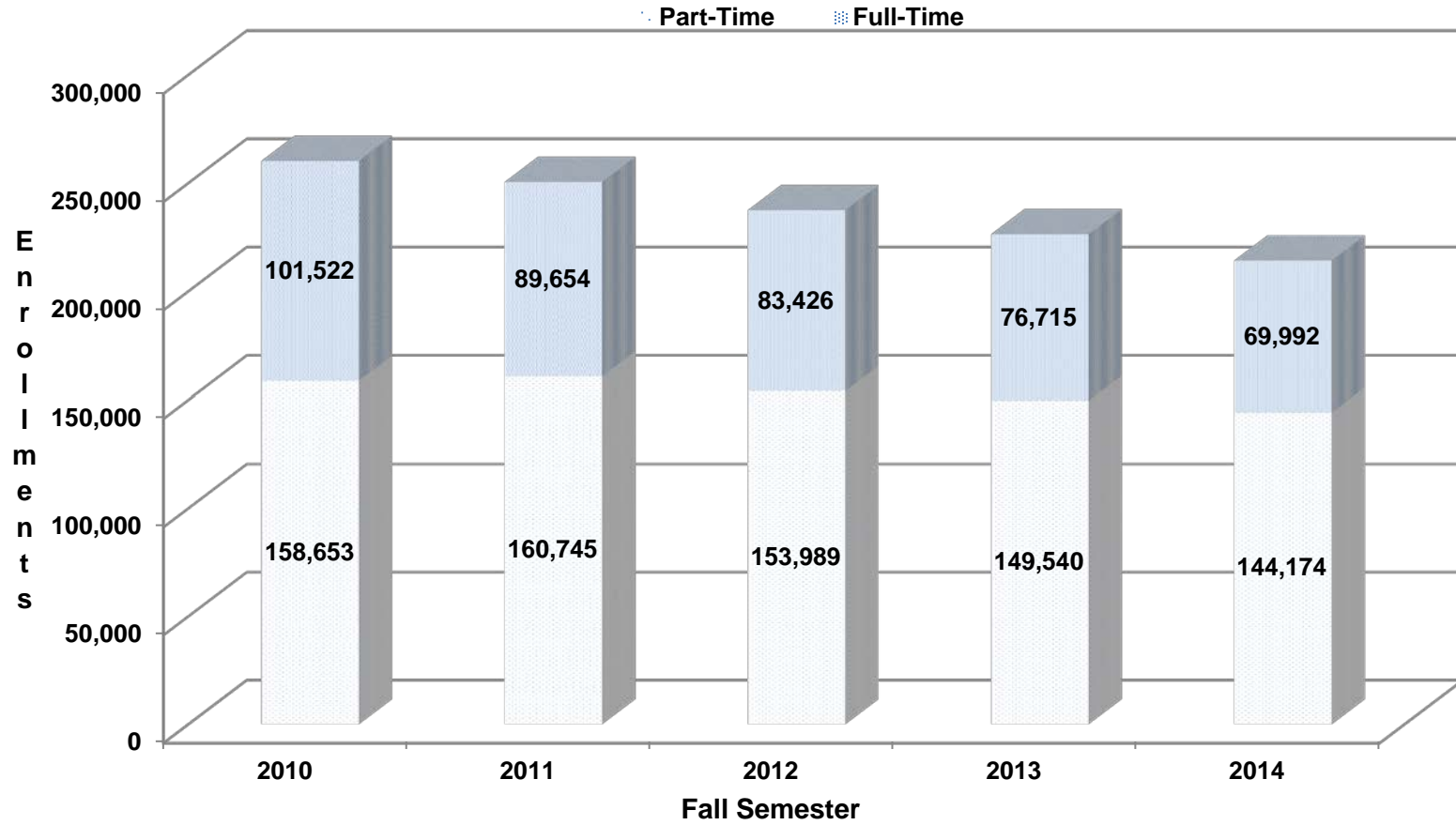

FALL 2014 ENROLLMENT BY AGE

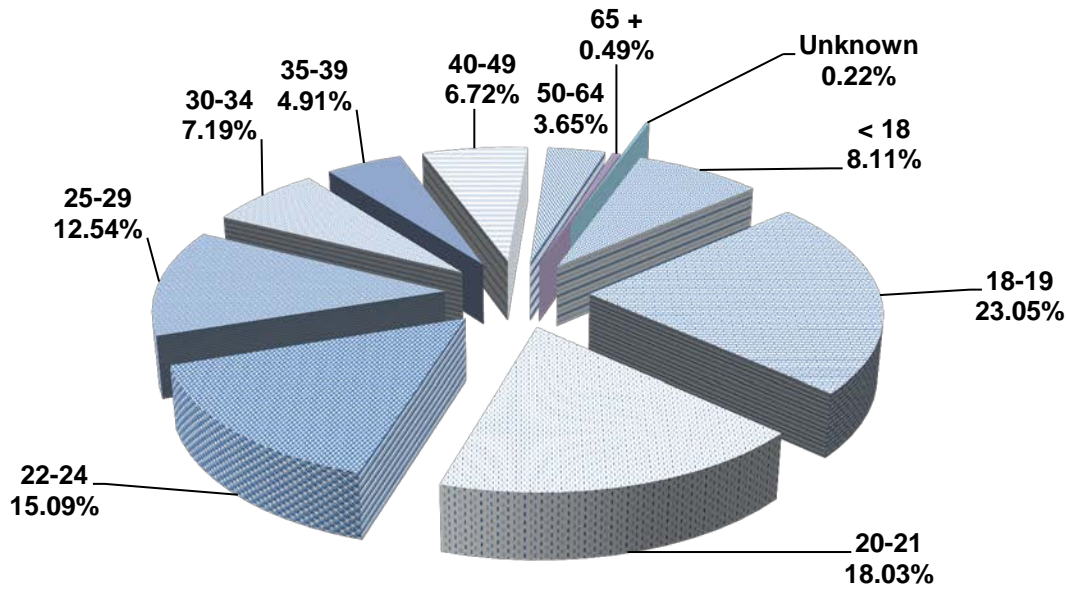
