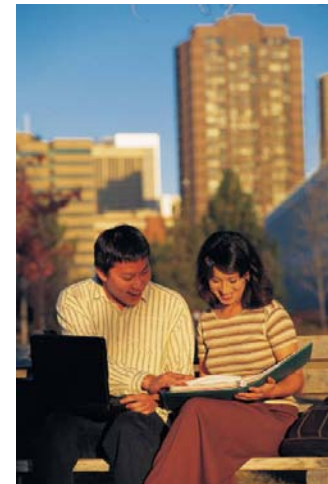

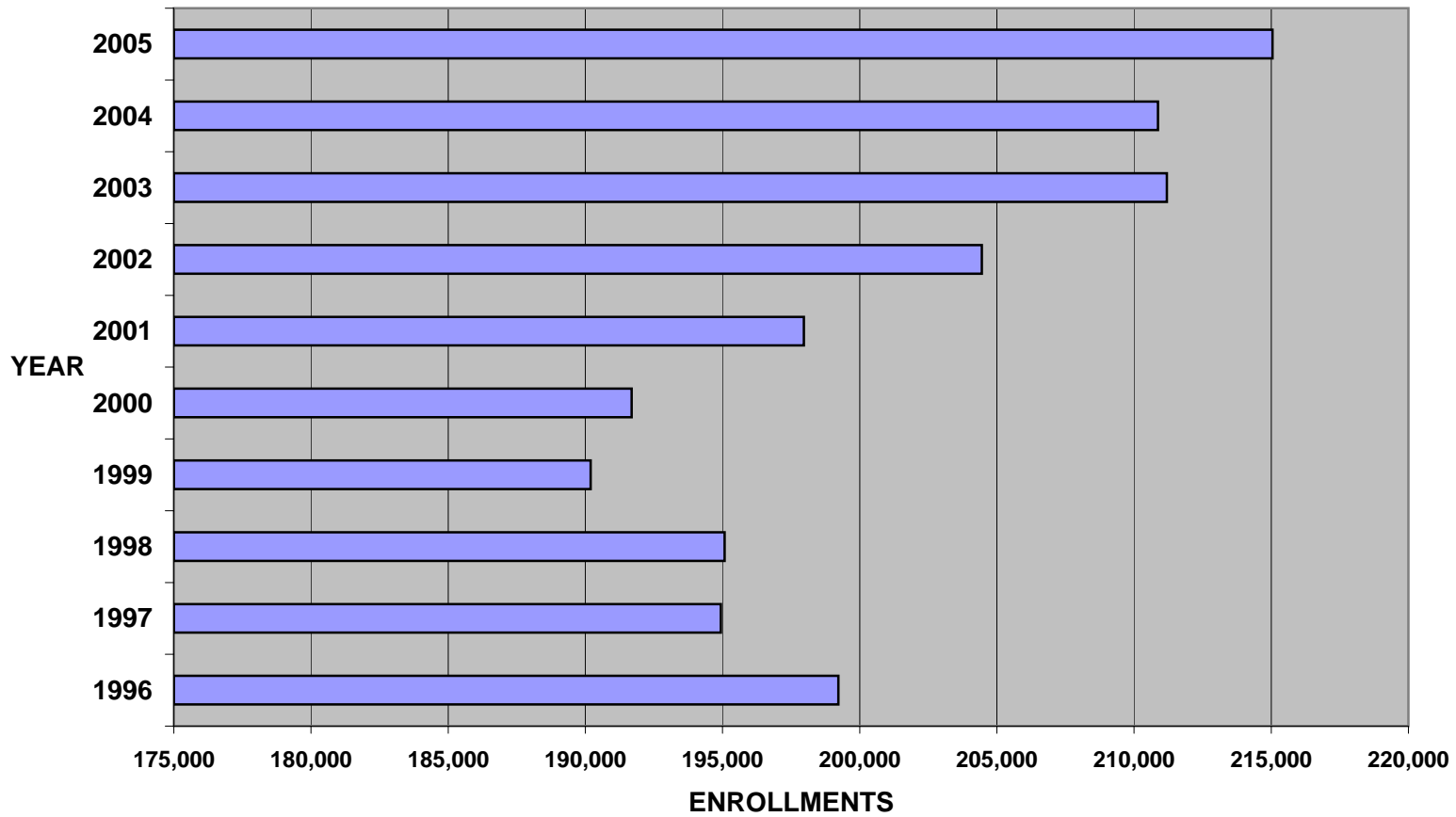

Fall 2005 ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY

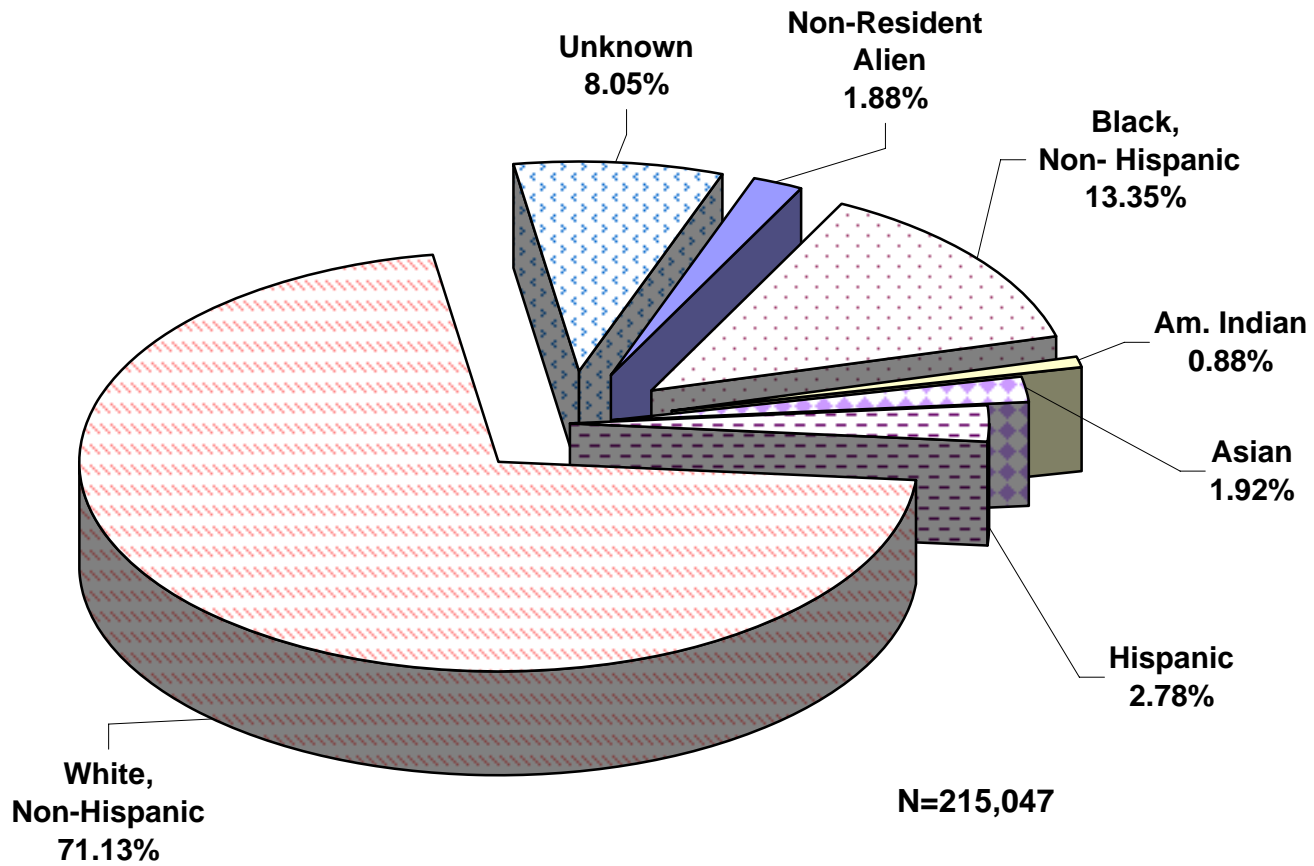

FITIAC'S AS A PERCENT OF FALL ENROLLMENT

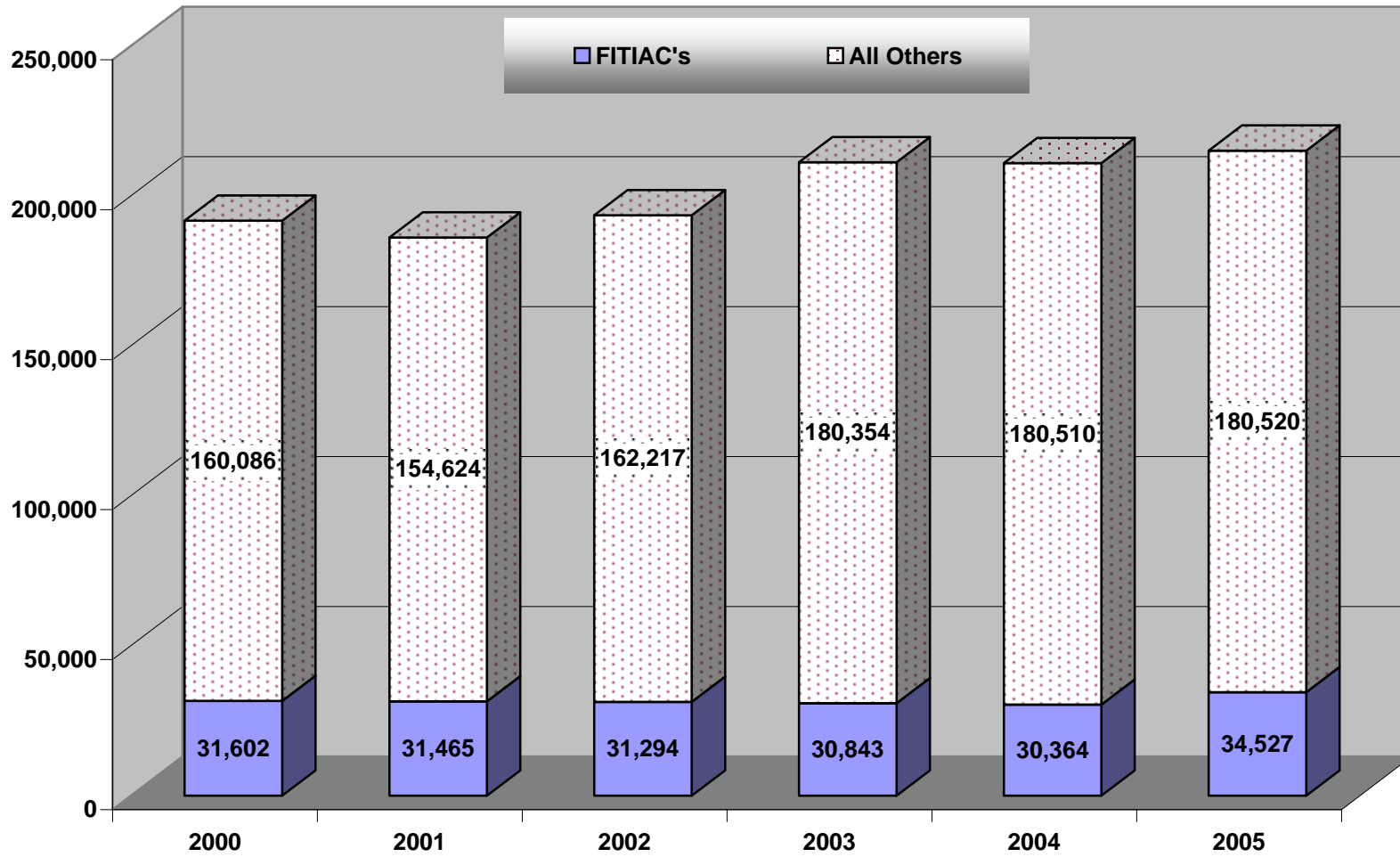

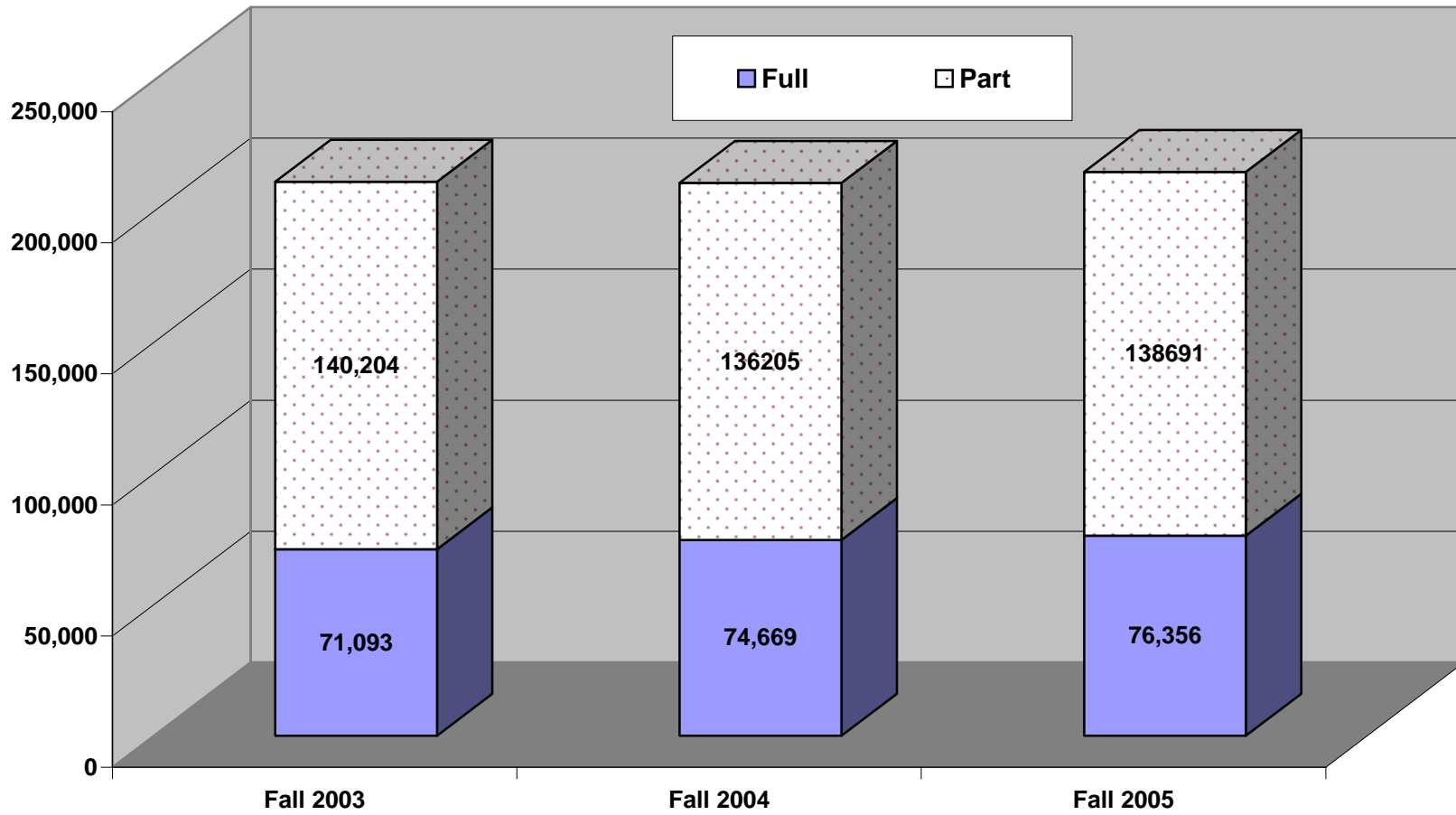

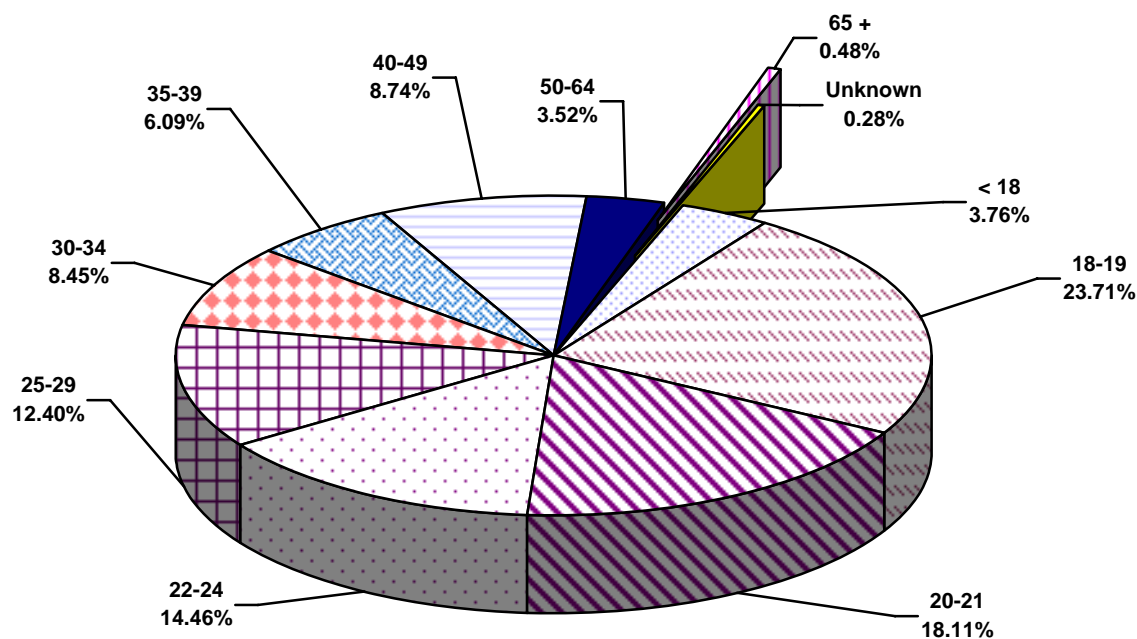
