TOTAL NON-PROGRAM ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY, 2004-05

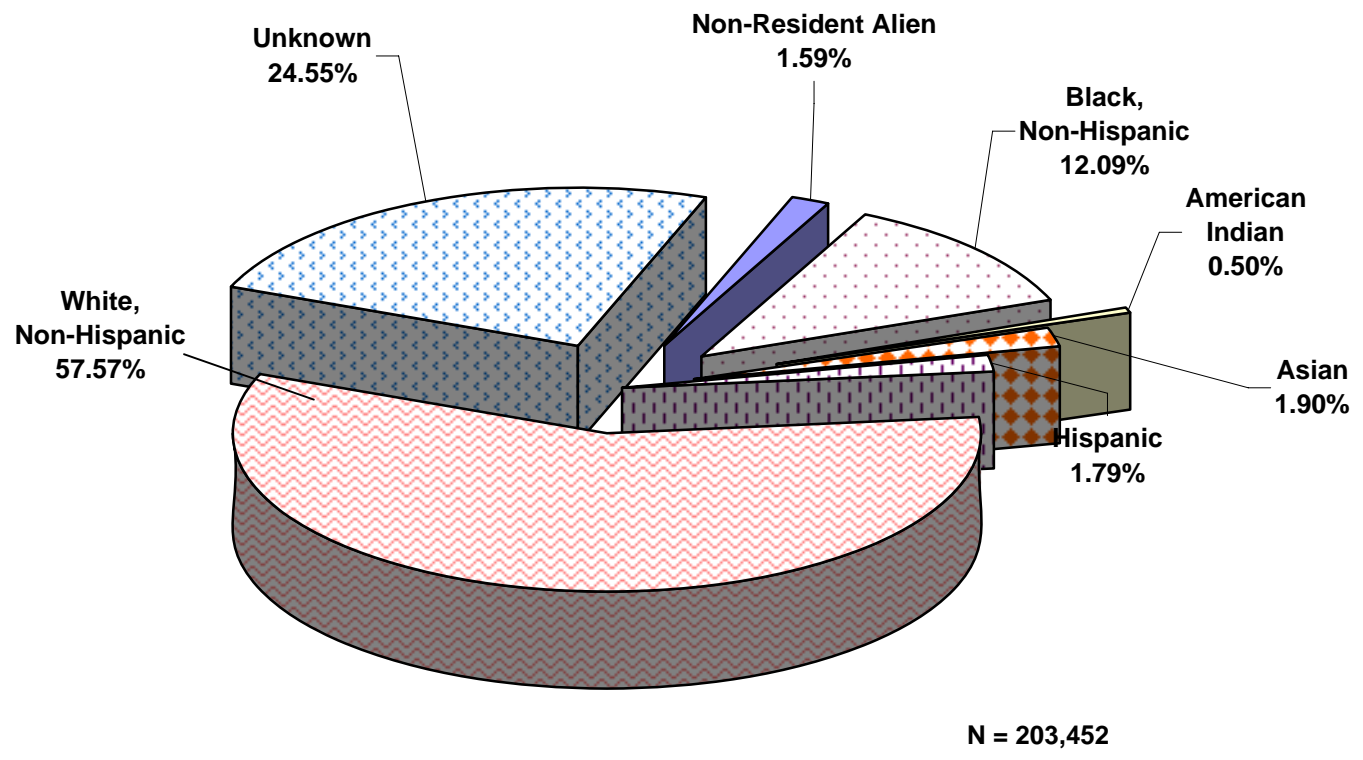
