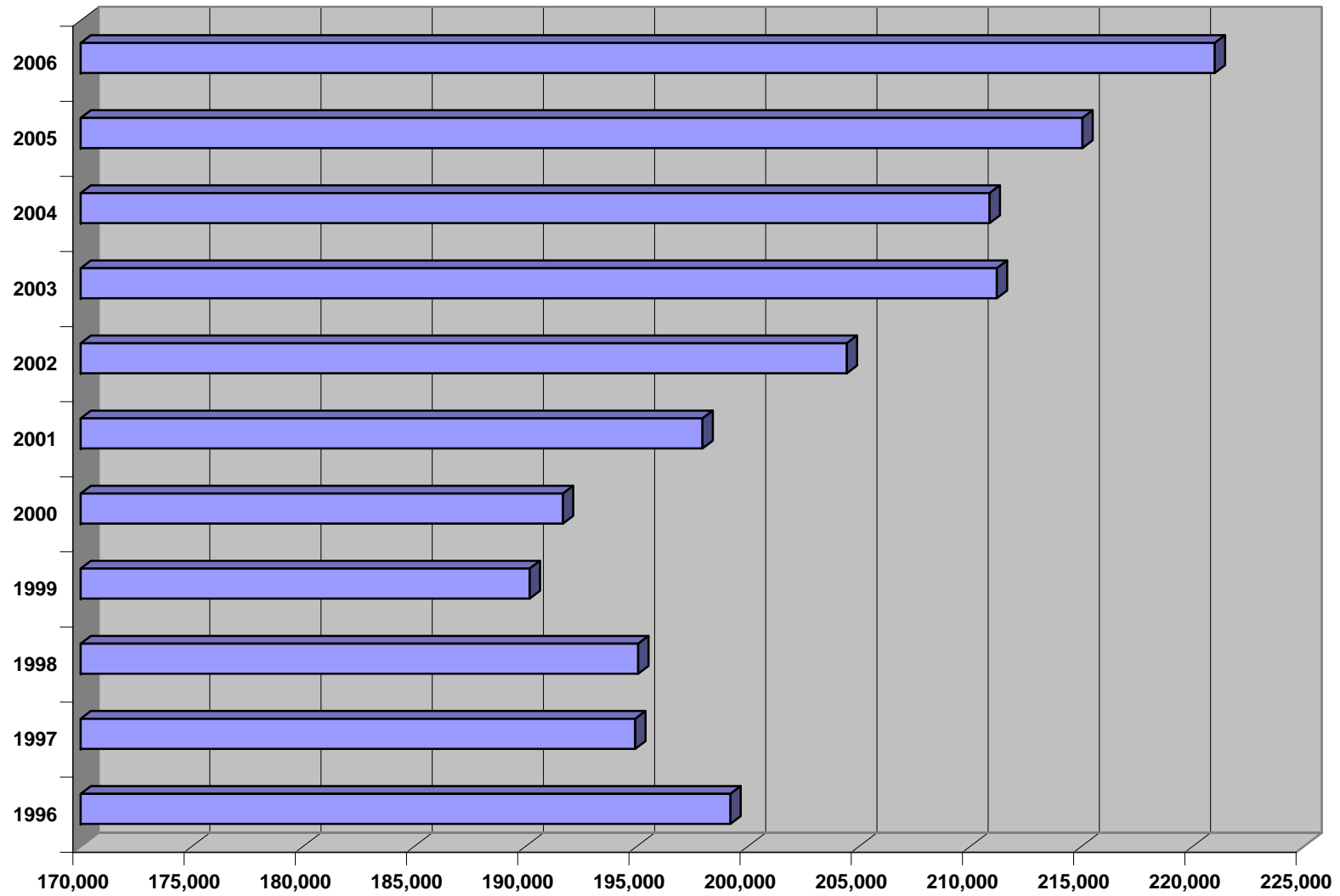

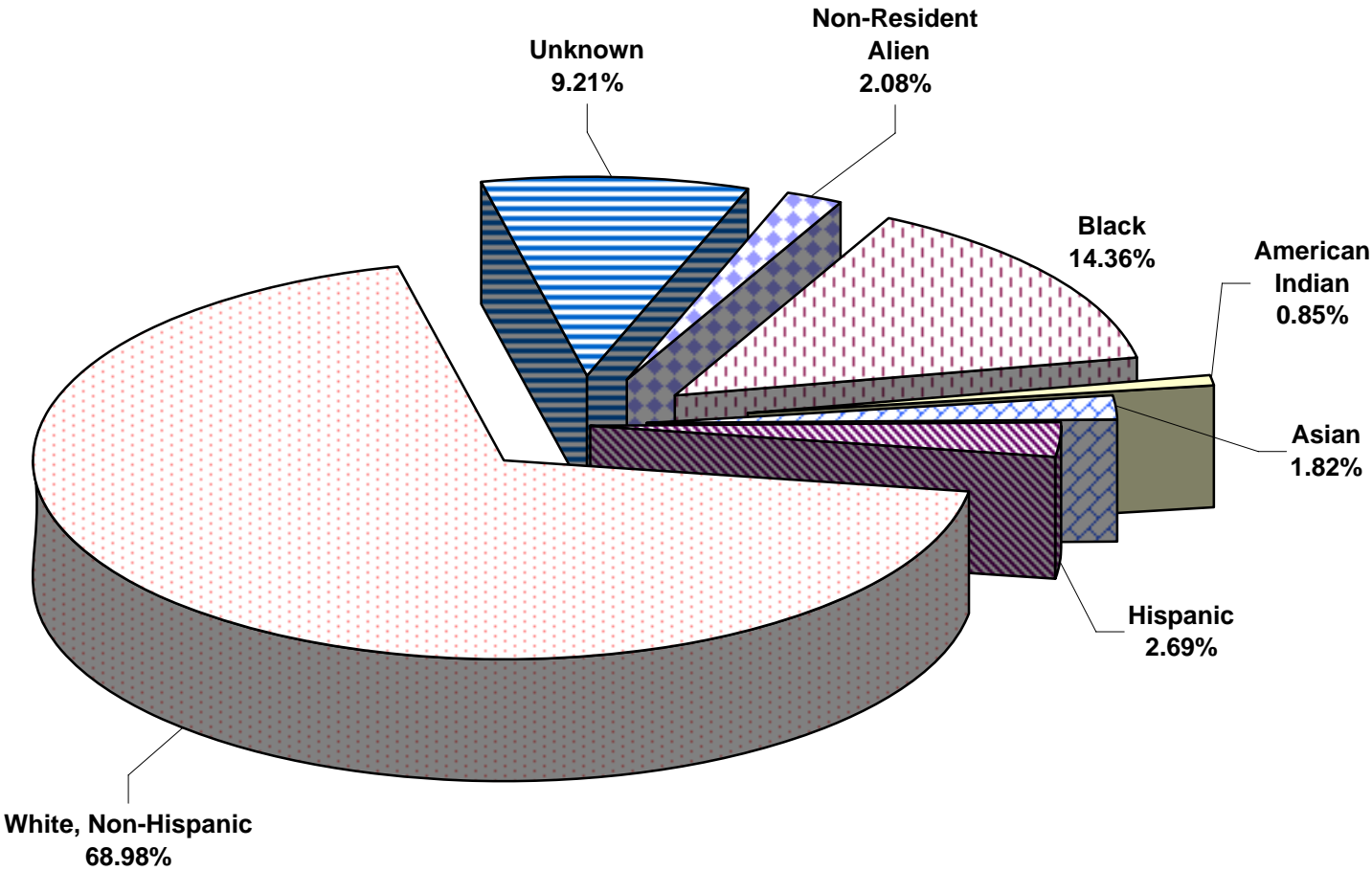

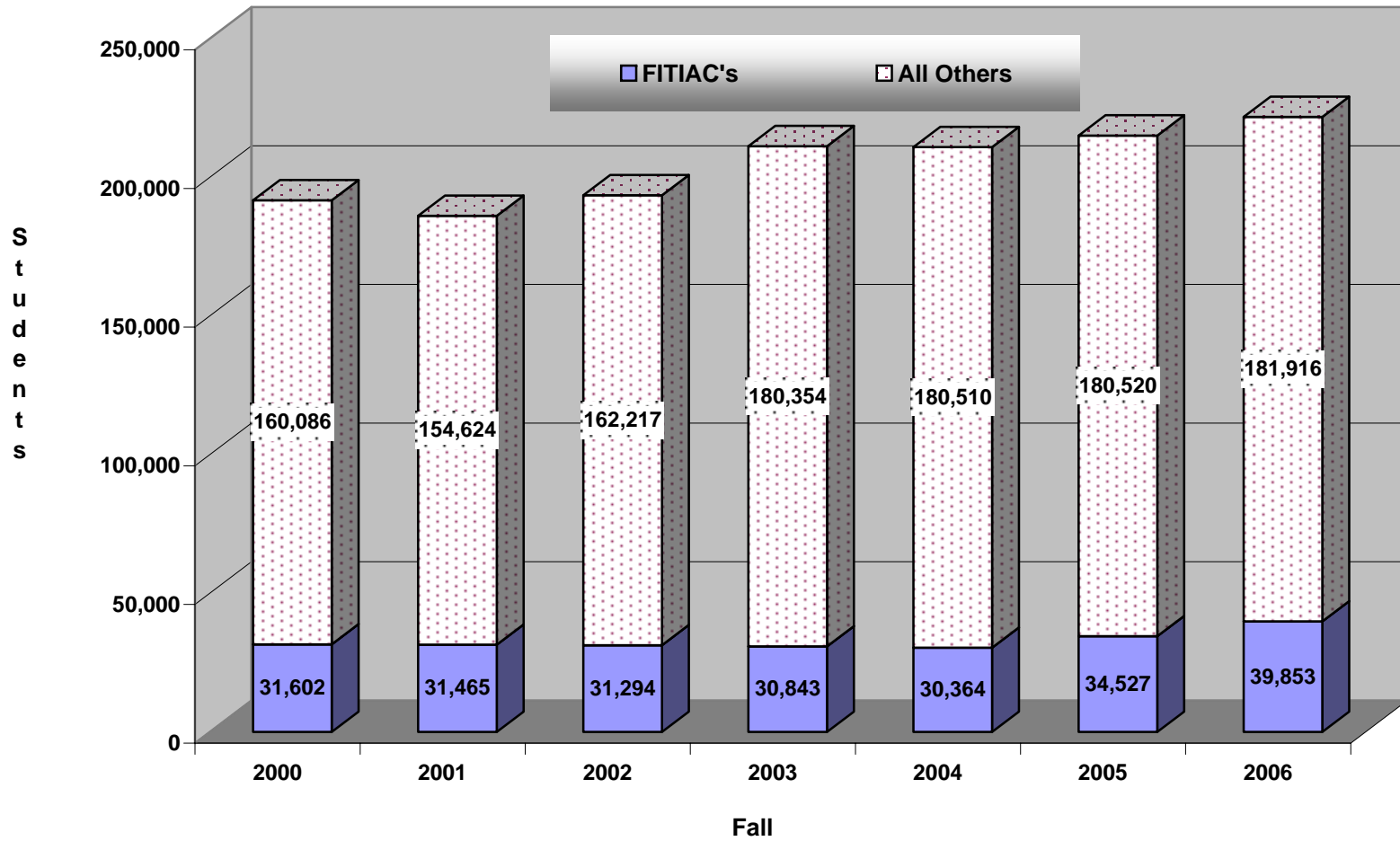
# FALL 2006 ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY

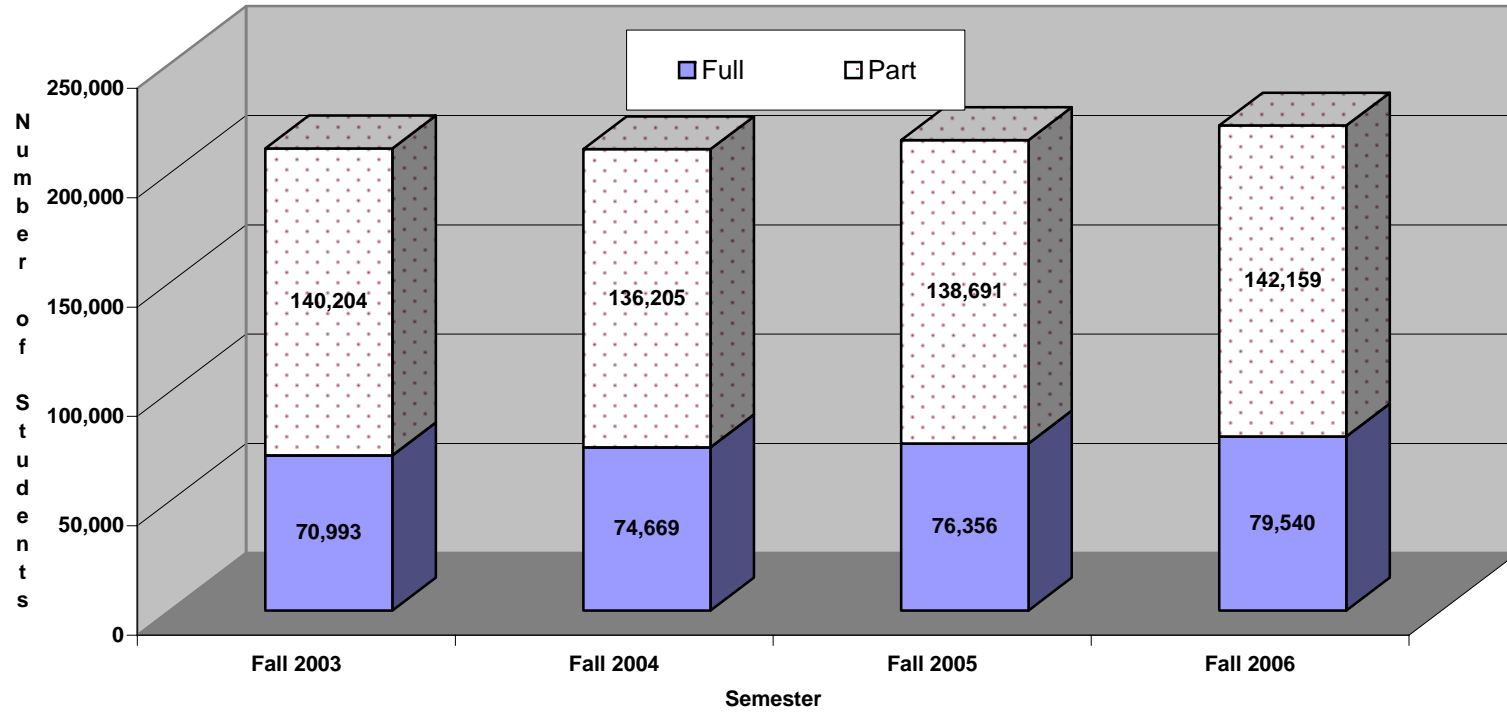

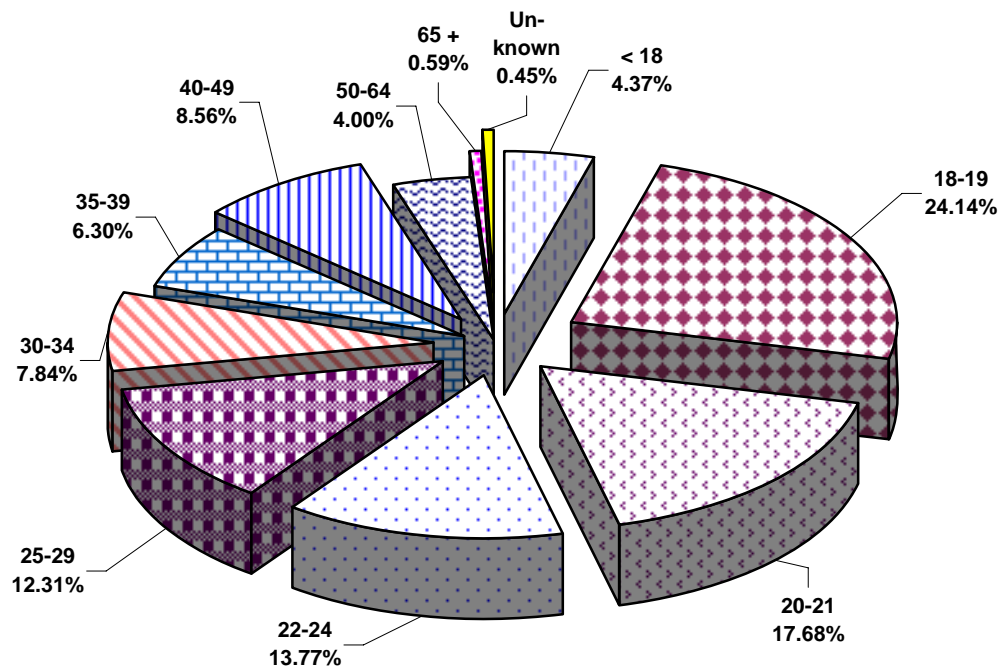
