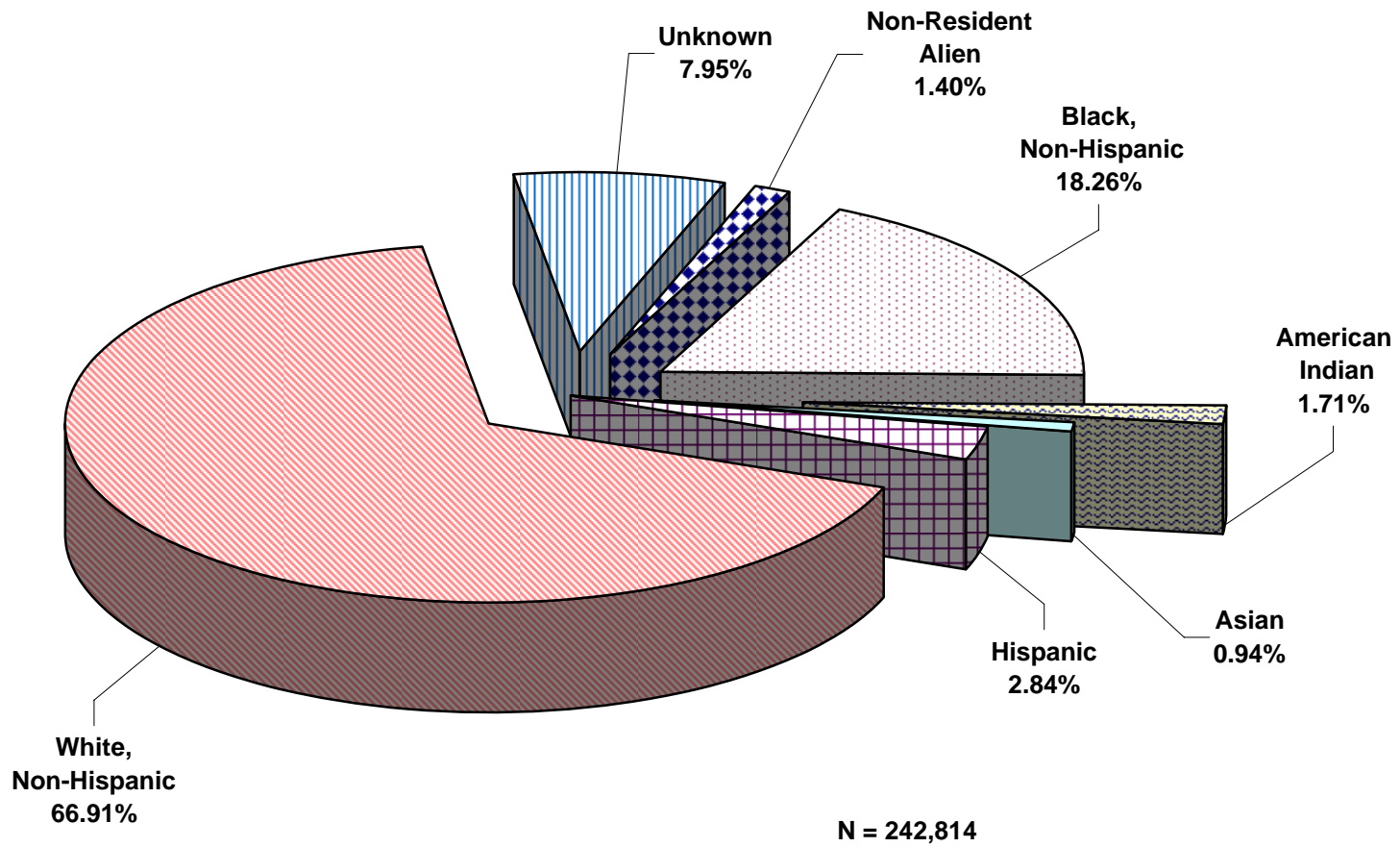


TOTAL YEAR-END PROGRAM ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY, 2006-07

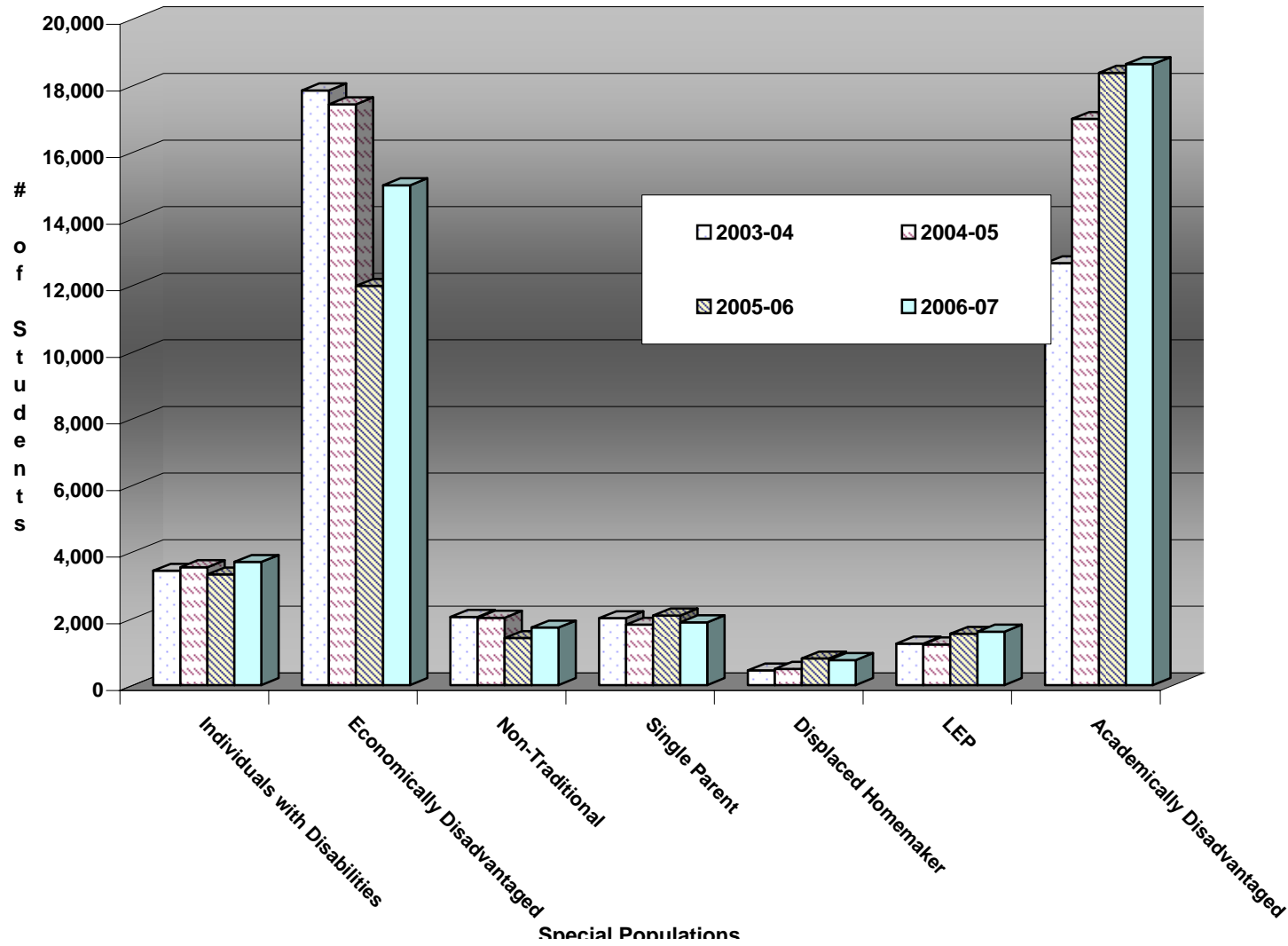
